All the information you need to register your 4-H group to attend 4-H Camp June 23-25, 2009 at Tushar Lake Campground is here! Our theme for this year is “CSI – Crime Scene Investigation”. We have many fun activities planned for our 4-Hers. Beaver County 4-H Camp is traditionally one of the largest 4-H camps in Utah. It’s one of a few camps that still camp for two nights and three days. We like to think it’s the funnest too! So don’t miss out.

Registration Deadline: Please have all your forms and money into our office or Shelley Jakino no later than **Friday, June 12th, 2009**. Hint: T-shirt sizes and campground reservations are given on a first-come, first-serve basis so your chances of getting what you want are better the earlier you register. Early registrations are also loved and much appreciated!

Day Camp: If you have a group of youth that want to come to camp, but you can’t spend the 3 days, day camp is the perfect solution. Day Camp is Wednesday, June 24th. The day campers will arrive around 9:00 a.m. on the 24th and will stay all day. They will eat with the Teen Council for lunch and dinner on that day.

Mess Hall News: We will provide lunch on Wednesday. You will need to bring food for two breakfasts and two dinners. Day campers are invited to eat with the camp counselors on Wednesday evening. The cost is included with your registration.

T-shirts! We will be ordering shirts on June 12th. Be sure and hand in your size choice with your registration. If we don’t have your registration in by the 12th of June we can’t guarantee you will get your t-shirts. The shirts are to be worn on Wednesday. T-shirts will be given to leaders on Tuesday at camp.

Cost: 4-H members \$25.00 for camp this year. (\$20.00 – for day campers.)

Leaders: \$10

Leaders will need to charge their 4-Hers for the other meals furnished at camp.

Trick -4- Treat: We will be trick or treating again. Please remember to bring about 200 pieces of wrapped candy for this event.

4H Member Enrollment Forms and Medical/Code of Conduct Forms: These two forms are now together on one sheet. These are a must! Every 4-Her and leader needs to turn a completed form with signatures in with their camp registrations to be officially enrolled in 4-H and to be able to attend camp.

Some groups also have a special meeting with parents to plan and organize camp where they discuss food, rides, and what to bring.
